CHARACTER AND PERSONAL QUALITIES:

- 1. Calling: A love and passion for leading God's people in worship.
- 2. **Prayerful:** Models living a life of prayer.
- 3. **Relational/Personable/Pastoral:** Excellent at making immediate connections, approachable, and caring.
- 4. **Relentlessly positive spirit:** Casts a spirit of hope and joy that contributes to a flourishing church.
- 5. **Intergenerational sensitivity:** Awareness of the needs of worshippers from a variety of ages and stages in life.
- 6. **Staff/Team commitment:** Commitment to the health and vitality of the staff and ministry teams, provides encouragement and support to fellow staff members.

COMPETENCIES, EXPERIENCE, AND MINISTRY SKILLS:

- Vibrant Faith: A clear testimony of faith in Jesus Christ and a vital, growing personal relationship with Him. Commitment to Holy Scripture and ability to meaningfully engage the Word of God in worship.
- 2. **Leadership:** Skilled in leading worship bands, preferably using guitar and vocals. Ability to lead individuals and teams in Christ-like ways, capable of handling difficult conversations.
- 3. **Effective Communication:** Excellent communication and social skills. Able to share vision and excitement for the ministry in a variety of settings.
- 4. **Team Builder:** Recruit, build and maintain effective teams and develop servant-leaders in each team.
- 5. **Organizational/Administrative Skills:** Ability to manage and complete organizational and administrative tasks (worship and event planning, scheduling, managing volunteers, etc.).
- 6. **Organizational Commitment**: Commitment to ECO Essential Tenets of Faith and to the mission and vision of CPC.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Lead the worshipping community; provide direction, encouragement and support to the band; and work with a team to coordinate various aspects of the service.

- 1. Oversee the contemporary worship service band, run rehearsals, recruit and train musicians.
- 2. Create and maintain a pool of volunteer musicians to play on Sundays and other occasions.
- 3. Work collaboratively with the Minister of Worship, paid musicians, sound engineer, interns, and volunteers.
- 4. Other Duties as time allows
- 5. Coordinate contemporary worship events outside of Sunday morning services (occasional Sunday night services, outreaches, concerts, etc.).
- 6. Community-building and connection for contemporary worship participants.
- 7. Work collaboratively with the Minister of Worship to pick songs, prepare slides, run rehearsals, schedule musicians and oversee the service.

Highly Desirable:

- 1. Bachelor's degree (or higher) in Worship, Music or Arts
- 2. At least 2 years of ministry experience
- 3. Worship service production and music studio experience
- 4. Experience with software such as CCLI, ProPresenter, Planning Center, and PowerPoint

POSITION DETAILS AND REPORTING:

The Contemporary Worship Leader will report to the Minister of Worship. This is a parttime, permanent position requiring 15-20 hours of work per week.

- 2. Share 2 or 3 experiences in your personal history that would translate to success in this role.
