

TITLE: Contemporary Worship Leader (part-time)

ORGANIZATION: Carmel Presbyterian Church (CPC). CPC is celebrating its 69th Anniversary of service to Carmel, CA and the Monterey Peninsula. With a membership of approximately 270, CPC is fortunate to also welcome many tourists, students, military personnel and other visitors to Carmel-by-the-Sea. PURPOSE: To follow and serve Jesus Christ and Carmel Presbyterian Church by providing leadership and organization for the Contemporary Worship service.

ACCOUNTABILITY: The Minister of Worship is the direct supervisor for this position.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Generally

Contemporary Worship Leader will lead the band and work with a team to coordinate various aspects of the service.

Specifically

- Oversee the contemporary worship service band, run rehearsals, recruit and train musicians.
- Create and maintain a pool of volunteer musicians to play on Sundays and other occasions.
- Work collaboratively with the Minister of Worship, paid musicians, sound engineer, interns, and volunteers.

Other Duties as time allows

- Coordinate contemporary worship events outside of Sunday morning services (occasional Sunday night services, outreaches, concerts, etc.).
- Community-building and connection for contemporary worship participants.

Administrative Specifics

- Work collaboratively with the Minister of Worship to pick songs, prepare slides, run rehearsals, schedule musicians and oversee the service.

CLASSIFICATION AND SCHEDULE:

This is a part-time, non-exempt position. Work hours will be flexible and will be determined with the Minister of Worship and may change. There will be meetings, rehearsals and other responsibilities on some evenings, Saturdays, and Sundays.

COMPENSATION: \$30/hour, 15-20 hours per week. Does not include benefits.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. A clear testimony of faith in Jesus Christ and a vital, growing personal relationship with Him.
2. Skilled in leading worship bands, preferably using guitar and vocals.
3. Commitment to ECO Tenets of Faith and commitment to the mission and vision of CPC.
4. Excellent communication and social skills, as well as organization and administrative skills.

HIGHLY DESIRABLE:

1. Bachelor's degree (or higher) in Worship, Music or Arts
2. At least 2 years of ministry experience
3. Worship service production and music studio experience
4. Experience with software such as CCLI, ProPresenter, Planning Center, and PowerPoint
